# <u>Hose Co 2 – March 2018 Drill</u> <u>Handline Operations</u>

Locations – SUNY OW – Vacant Dorms

### All 3 Person Hands On evolutions

(Operator can be Instructor – No water being flowed, just for communications)

Objective 1. -

# Pulling Mattydale or Crosslay:

- Nozzle Pulling folds and keeping folds in tack to front door, then staging for entry
- Back up Pulling folds and keeping folds in tack to front door, then staging for entry behind Nozzles hose
- Control clearing bed getting hose taut from engine to back up position before orders to charge.

# Objective 2. -

# Pulling combo Line:

- Keeping nozzle Horseshoe in tack to fire floor stairway door,
  Where dropped and staged up the stairs for easy advancement using gravity to their advantage
  - Want to see doors chocked open so not pinching hose as charges
- Keep Back up Horseshoe in tack to the ½ landing below where the nozzle horseshoe was dropped, it's to be staged up the stairs and out of the way of the doorway will be entering.
- Coordination between Control position and Chauffeur lines counted, "accurate count" of lines pulled from bed
  - $\circ$  Once total length figured " Nozzle or Officer "stating were in place"

 Control follows, hose all the way to back up, staging hose for easy advancement.

#### Objective 3.

### Creating a combo Line from dead bed:

Same objectives as above with the 4 positions: This time going floor above 1<sup>st</sup>.

This time Nozzle - taking 50' Dead bed 1 ¾ hose ( to Same as a

Back Up - taking 50' Dead bed 1 ¾ hose

<u>Control</u> - getting 100' 1 ¾ off bed, attaching to 2 ½ dead bed continuing Rest of way

 Want to see Control ask Chauffer how much is on 1<sup>st</sup> length the add 50' more then.

#### Objective 4.

### Setting and Staging Standpipe Hose in Stairways:

Using 3 Lengths standpipe hose (No Stand Pipe outlet – control will verbalized what they would do) - Floor below door of entry:

Connect 3 lengths and stage hose for entry into fire floor

#### Objective 5.

# Packing a Mattydale/Cross Lay :

- $\circ$  50' in 1 layer of hose then long loops
- 100' the 2<sup>nd</sup> long loops ( neither to obstruct pump panel)
- Packed so 1 nozzle out either side of engine

#### Objective 6.

#### Packing the combo Line :

- Setting a nozzle horseshoe
- Setting a back up Horseshoe
- Setting hose in bed ( Packing dead bed hose )

# Objective 7. Packing Standpipe hose :

- Creating 50' lengths
- Creating 100 Packs

Objectives 1 - 3 are the basis of all fires we'll go to, <u>do these proficiently</u> = the sooner we get water on the fire = the sooner things will get better = the more lives and property can be saved.

As Basic as some make perceive this drill, we continue to struggle. Depending on who is there, build that muscle memory, that the thinking away from the equation!
