

Westbury FD Refresher 2 – Hands On Stations

Instructor(s) will brief group on Refresher II's objectives and address all safety concerns with Truck Company Operations utilized in this drill. All members operating in a team assignment will do so utilizing full PPE for such team assignment.

Instructor will then have all members in attendance count in sequence: 1, 2, 3 ... until all members are accounted for; these numbers should be remembered by the member calling out them, since these numbers will make up the team assignments.

Team 1 (members # 1 & # 2) **Laddering/OV**

- Team pulls extension ladder from side of engine (1 Person) *once up gets a partner*
- Vent 2 of the 2nd floor window front of training building – (note wind direction...)
- Review leg lock – tool carry, securing ladder, taking the window top down
- Reset ladder – below window a and VES (verbal review – sound floor, close door ...)

Team 2 (members # 3 & 4) **Setting Roof Ladder**

- Team pulls an Extension ladder and Roof ladder for 962/963 carry to rear of training building
- Bean raise ladder to peaked area, then set the roof ladder to the peak (**20' for job**)
(rest of the members can watch from platform)

Team 3 (members # 5 & 6) **Prepping a Saw / Staging Tools for Roof Operations**

- Pull saw from rig, check and start (start w/ metal blade have change to a wood)
- Carry all tools needed for a roof operations to the roof (use rope encouraged for saw)
- (saw, hook 10'+, irons, recue rope at minimum)

Team 4 (members # 7 & 8) **Cutting a Roof**

- Start saw – cut 7-9-8 to pallets set up – partner will back up
- Make sure notches cut
- Review pulling material
- Review clearing the ceiling below

Team 5 (members # 9 & 10) **Use of Electrical Equipment**

- pull electric fan, junction box, pigtail, fan hanger from rig
- set negative pressure – at door
- reset and make it positive pressure
- w/ same junction box set up a light
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Team 6 (members # 11 & 12) **Forcing Doors**

- w/ set of irons – outward opening door – on door mock up
- flip members – inward opening door w/ hydro ram
- w/ door mock up – k-tool operation (verbal demo pulling lock but both using key tools)

Team 7 (members # 13 & 14) **Preparing for Aerial Ladder Operations**

- assist chauffer of 962/963 – set the outriggers – review if ground is bad
- bring bucket to ground (if using 962)
- secure members in the bucket w/ harness or belt – review what tools should be going up with them

Team 8 (members # 15 & 16) **Removing and stowing Ladders**

- remove the roof ladder in rear roof
- remove ladder in rear (on beam) and stow on ladder truck
- remove ladder in front and stow on engine

Entire Groups together: (**Instructor Review**)

- All Safety concerns will be readdressed - confirming
- Ropes – Utility vs. Lifesaving vs. search rope (note: personal webbing – tag line)
- Salvage – note equipment and when needs to be done
